

DICE GOLF

HOLE RULES:

Roll the dice...

- HOLE 1: Until a "6" appears on either die.
- HOLE 2: Until the sum is divisible by "3".
- HOLE 3: Until the sum is a multiple of "5".
- HOLE 4: Until the difference is "4".
- HOLE 5: Until the sum is divisible by "2".
- HOLE 6: Until a "1" is shown on either die.
- HOLE 7: Until you have a sum less than "5".
- HOLE 8: Until you have a sum less than "7".
- HOLE 9: Until you have a sum divisible by "4".

OBJECT OF THE GAME:

- To get the lowest score possible for all 9 holes.
- Players will use all mathematical processes while following the rules for the game.

SET UP:

- Run off 1 copy of the game for each set of partners.
- Provide a pair of dice for each group.

PROCEDURES:

- The number of rolls needed to successfully complete the directions for that hole is your score for the hole.
- Each player must successfully complete the first hole before anyone may progress to the second hole.
- Play will continue until all players have completed all 9 holes.
- Scores will be totaled at the end.

SCORING:

- The player with the lowest score wins.

VARIATIONS:

- Change the rules for each hole.
- Play 18 holes, or a tournament, instead of nine holes.
