

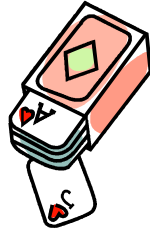
O'NO 99



An Addition Game of Additional Fun!

Materials: (A deck can be made from 3 decks of cards)

- 3 each of 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9
- 10 10 cards
- 4 Jacks
- 4 Queens
- 6 Kings
- 4 Aces
- 2 Jokers



Card Values:

- Cards 2 through 10 = face value
- Jacks = hold (the score does not change)
- Queens = minus 10 (subtract 10 from the total)
- Kings = reverse play direction
- Aces = no points: can only be played when the total ends in a zero...and it is your play.
- Jokers = double play (the next person must play twice)

Play:

- Deal 4 cards to each player
- Put the remainder of the deck in the center upside down
- The first player lays a card and says the total.
- Players should draw after each turn, but may NOT draw once the next person has gone.
- The next player plays and adds his/her card to the total, or follow the direction of an "action" card.
- Play continues until someone is forced to play a card that either equals or is above 99 points.

Notes:

- A double play may be reversed...and the player who played it has to make the double play, or can reverse it back.
- A double play is made by playing, drawing, playing and drawing again.
