








# FAIRY TALE COURT...CLOSING ARGUMENT

CRITERIA	EXEMPLARY	PROFICIENT	NEEDS WORK/DO OVER
<p>OPENING ADDRESS</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Respectfully addresses jury.</li> <li>• Grabs the jury's attention with a WOW.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Addresses the jury.</li> <li>• Grabs the jury's attention.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does not address jury.</li> <li>• Has no attention grabber.</li> </ul>
<p>APPEAL TO EMOTIONS</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• States more than one positive about the client</li> <li>• Makes a statement that clearly appeals to the jury's emotions.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• States one positive about the client.</li> <li>• Makes a statement that somewhat appeals to the jury's emotions.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• States no positives about the client.</li> <li>• Does not attempt to appeal to the jury's emotions.</li> </ul>
<p>EVIDENCE</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All (3 or more) pieces of evidence fit together to persuade the jury of client's innocence.</li> <li>• Displays the evidence.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Has three pieces of evidence. At least two pieces prove the client's innocence.</li> <li>• Discusses the evidence.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Has less than three pieces of evidence, or the pieces do not prove innocence.</li> <li>• Does not discuss the evidence.</li> </ul>
<p>CLOSING STATEMENT</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clearly and emotionally makes a final plea for a "not guilty" verdict.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Makes a final plea for a "not guilty" verdict.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does not make a final plea for a "not guilty" verdict.</li> </ul>
<p>DELIVERY</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dramatically delivers argument with expression, excitement, and enthusiasm.</li> <li>• The entire argument is grammatically correct.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Delivers argument with sufficient expression, excitement and enthusiasm.</li> <li>• Most of the argument is grammatically correct.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Delivers argument without much expression, excitement or enthusiasm.</li> <li>• Several grammatical errors in the argument.</li> </ul>
